

The design process adopted gives inputs into core functional areas along with inter-disciplinary fields through its problem-solving methods. Fashion design, illustration and pattern making are interactive disciplines embedded in the course. Through the introduction of 'Plastic Surgery Cutting', 3D processes for design development can be considered for silhouette, texture and construction. The notion of interpretation is central to creative pattern cutting and is key to the building of a new visual language in silhouette and shape. Illustrations, designs, samples and prototypes emerge throughout the design development of cutting and draping, which in turn, informs an individual creative design process, placing body, materials, structure and form at its core. The aim is to incorporate 'Lifestyle' management in the professional and personal life of every student, to evaluate each student's progress and to provide the institution continuous feedback on the performance and development of all participants taking part in the course.
